# An Act to amend the Harbors Act, 1936-1978.

[Assented to 19 March 1981]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Harbors Act Amendment Act, 1981".
- (2) The Harbors Act, 1936-1978, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Harbors Act, 1936-1981".

Amendment of s. 80— Power to lease public wharves.

- 2. Section 80 of the principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "any term not exceeding twenty-one years, either by public auction or by public tender" and substituting the passage "such period, and on such conditions, as the Minister thinks proper";

and

(b) by striking out subsection (2).

Amendment of s. 114— Liability of owner and master.

- 3. Section 114 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection:
  - (1a) No civil liability attaches to a pilot or to the Minister or to the Crown for negligence by a pilot in relation to the pilotage of a ship, other than a ship belonging to the Crown.

Amendment of s. 124— Responsibility for injury to the works of the Minister.

- 4. Section 124 of the principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by striking out from subsection (1b) the passage "In any proceedings" and substituting the passage "Subject to subsection (1c), in any proceedings";

and

- (b) by inserting after subsection (1b) the following subsection:
  - (1c) Negligence on the part of a pilot does not constitute ground for a defence, or for making an allowance in the assessment of damages, under subsection (1b).
- 5. Section 144 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph Amendment of a 144— (70b) the following paragraph:

Regulations.

(70c) requiring the holder of any licence or permit or other authority granted under this Act to indemnify the Minister against any claims for injury or damage that may arise as a result of the exercise of rights conferred by the licence, permit or other authority.
