An Act to amend the Highways Act, 1926-1954.

[Assented to 1st December, 1955.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Highways Act Amendment Act, 1955".
- (2) The Highways Act, 1926-1954, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Highways Act, 1926-1955".
- (3) The Highways Act, 1926-1954, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of s. 31 of principal Act— Highways Fund.

- 3. (1) Section 31 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (iii) of subsection (3) thereof.
- (2) The amendment made by this section shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and fifty-five.

Enactment of s. 31a of principal Act4. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 31 thereof:—

Adjustments of Highways Fund.

31a. (1) The Treasurer may out of the Loan Fund pay into the Highways Fund any sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate six hundred and twenty thousand pounds.

- (2) Every such sum shall be deemed to be an advance to the Highways Fund and shall be repaid to the Loan Fund out of moneys in the Highways Fund in such instalments and at such times as the Treasurer directs.
- (3) The Treasurer may transfer from the Highways Fund to the credit of the Consolidated Revenue Account any sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate six hundred and twenty thousand pounds.
- (4) This section without further appropriation shall be sufficient authority for every payment and transfer mentioned in this section.
