An Act to amend the Hospitals Act, 1934-1952.

[Assented to 27th November, 1958.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Hospitals Act Amendment Act, 1958".

(2) The Hospitals Act, 1934-1952, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Hospitals Act, 1934-1958".

(3) The Hospitals Act, 1934-1952, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by the Governor by proclamation.

Incorporation.

3. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of s. 33 of principal Act—Advisory Committee.

4. (1) Section 33 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (2) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsections :—

(2) The Committee shall consist of a Chairman and nine other members.

(2a) The Chairman shall be a person appointed by the Governor on the nomination of the Minister.

(2b) The members of the Committee other than the Chairman shall be respectively nominated as follows :—

One by the Council of the University of Adelaide :

One by the Faculty of Medicine of the said University :

One by the Council of the Royal Australian College of Physicians :

One by the Council of the Royal Australian College of Surgeons :

One by the Faculty of Dentistry of the said University:

Two by the board :

Two by members of the honorary medical staff of the Adelaide Hospital.

(2) Subsection (5) of section 33 is amended by striking out the proviso thereto and inserting in lieu thereof the following proviso :—

Provided that any five members shall constitute a quorum at a meeting of the Committee.
