### No. 98 of 1971

An Act to amend the Hire-Purchase Agreements Act,  
1960-1966.

[Assented to 3rd December, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Hire-Purchase Agreements Act Amendment Act, 1971". Short titles.

(2) The Hire-Purchase Agreements Act, 1960-1966, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Hire-Purchase Agreements Act, 1960-1971".

(3) The Hire-Purchase Agreements Act, 1960-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which the Door to Door Sales Act, 1971, comes into operation. Commencement.

3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act immediately after section 1 thereof:— Enactment of s. 1a of principal Act—

1a. This Act shall not be construed as affecting, limiting or restricting the operation or effect of the Door to Door Sales Act, 1971. Operation of Door to Door Sales Act, 1971, not affected.

**4. Section 47 of the principal Act is amended—**

(a) by inserting after the passage “the agreement shall” the passage “, subject to subsection (2) of this section,”;

and

(b) by inserting after the present contents thereof as amended (which are hereby designated subsection (1) thereof) the following subsection:—

(2) Where the hire-purchase agreement referred to in subsection (1) of this section is a contract or agreement to which the Door to Door Sales Act, 1971, applies that hire-purchase agreement shall not be avoided pursuant to that subsection if the deposit referred to in that subsection is obtained from the proposed hirer as soon as practicable after the right of the proposed hirer to terminate that hire-purchase agreement pursuant to that Act has ceased to exist.
