An Act to amend the Hairdressers Registration Act, 1939-1946.

[Assented to 13th December, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Hairdressers Registration Act Amendment Act, 1951".
- (2) The Hairdressers Registration Act, 1939-1946, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Hairdressers Registration Act, 1939-1951".
- (3) The Hairdressers Registration Act, 1939-1946, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 21—
Fees.

- 2. Section 21 of the principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by striking out the words "one pound one shilling" in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one pound eleven shillings and sixpence";
  - (b) by striking out the words "one shilling" in paragraph (b) of subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "eleven shillings and six pence";
  - (c) by striking out the words "one shilling" in the fourth line of subsection (4) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "eleven shillings and six pence".

- 3. Section 29 of the principal Act is amended—
- Amendment of principal Act, s. 29—
- (a) by inserting after the word "letters" in the third line of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) thereof the words assuming style of hairdresser, etc. association or institute or under any like name or title";
- (b) by inserting after the word "letters" in the third line of paragraph (b) of subsection (1) thereof the words "or whether under the name of a company, association or institute or under any like name or title ".
