**An Act to amend the Juries Act, 1927.**

*[Assented to 10 November 1985]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- Short title.           1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Juries Act Amendment Act, 1985".  
                           (2) The Juries Act, 1927, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
- Commencement.       2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.
- Amendment of  
third schedule.       3. The third schedule to the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "that is concerned with the administration of justice or the punishment of offenders" and substituting the passage "whose duties of office are connected with the investigation of offences, the administration of justice or the punishment of offenders".
