An Act to amend the Justices Act, 1921.

[Assented to 10 March 1988]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Justices Act Amendment Act, 1988". Short title.

(2) The Justices Act, 1921, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 27a of the principal Act is amended by inserting in subparagraph (i) of paragraph (b) of subsection (3) "or, in the case of an alleged offence against the Electoral Act, 1985, not more than six months after that day". Amendment of s. 27a—
Service of summons by post.
