An Act to amend the Licensing Act, 1967-1982.

[Assented to 2 September 1982]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Licensing Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1982". Short titles.

(2) The Licensing Act, 1967-1982, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Licensing Act, 1967-1982".

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the definition of "liquor" in subsection (1) the following definition: Amendment of s. 4—
Interpretation.

"member" of the licensing court means the Judge or an Acting Judge of the licensing court, a special magistrate designated under this Act as a member of the licensing court, or a person appointed under this Act as a licensing court magistrate.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out subsection (2);

and

(b) by inserting in subsection (6) after the passage "the Judge under this Act" the passage "and a person so appointed shall be an Acting Judge of the court". Amendment of s. 5—
Constitution of licensing court.
