An Act to amend the Licensing Act, 1967

[Assented to 24 May 1984]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Licensing Act Amendment Act, 1984".

(2) The Licensing Act, 1967, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 18th day of April, 1984.

Insertion of new s. 4a.

Moratorium on the grant of licences of certain classes.

3. The following section is inserted after section 4 of the principal Act:

4a. (1) No licence of a prescribed class shall be granted upon an application made after the relevant date.

(2) In this section—

"licence of a prescribed class" means a licence of any of the following classes:

- (a) wine licence;
- (b) distiller's storekeeper's licence;
- (c) club licence;
- (d) cabaret licence;
- (e) twenty litre licence:

"the relevant date" means the 18th day of April, 1984.
