An Act to amend the Life Assurance Companies Act, 1936-1939.

[Assented to 20th November, 1941.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Life Assurance Companies Act Amendment Act, 1941". Short titles.

(2) The Life Assurance Companies Act, 1936-1939, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Life Assurance Companies Act, 1936-1941".

(3) The Life Assurance Companies Act, 1936-1939, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 53 of the principal Act is amended so as to read as follows :— Amendment of s. 53 of principal Act—

53. If within twelve months after the end of the period within which a company is required by this Act to deposit any document in the office of the Registrar, any person, being a shareholder, member or policy holder of the company, requests the company to forward to him a printed copy of that document, the company shall within fourteen days after receipt of the request, deliver or post such a copy to the said person. Duty to furnish copies of documents, etc.
