An Act to amend the Lottery and Gaming Act,
1936-1964.

[Assented to 9th December, 1965.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Lottery and Gaming Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1965".

(2) The Lottery and Gaming Act, 1936-1964, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Lottery and Gaming Act, 1936-1965".

(3) The Lottery and Gaming Act, 1936-1964, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. Paragraph (a) of section 19 of the principal Act is amended by inserting at the end thereof the following passage:—

Notwithstanding the provisions of this paragraph no licence granted under this Act shall sanction the use of any totalizator on the Morphettville Racecourse for more than sixteen days in the year One thousand nine hundred and sixty-five or on the said racecourse for more than eighteen days in the year One thousand nine hundred and sixty-six.
