An Act to amend section 22 of the Lottery and Gaming Act, 1936.

[Assented to 6th October, 1938.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Lottery and Gaming Act Amendment Act, 1938".

(2) The Lottery and Gaming Act, 1936, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Lottery and Gaming Act Amendment Act, 1936-1938".

(3) The Lottery and Gaming Act, 1936, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

**Amendment of principal Act, s. 22—
Permits to hold trotting races.**

2. Subsection (5) of section 22 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "twenty-five" and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "twenty".
