An Act to amend the Libraries and Institutes Act, 1939-1967.

[Assented to 11th April, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Libraries and Institutes Act Amendment Act, 1974".

(2) The Libraries and Institutes Act, 1939-1967, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Libraries and Institutes Act, 1939-1974".

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of principal Act, 8, 7— Constitution of board. 3. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "seven members appointed by the Governor." and inserting in lieu thereof the following passage:—

eight members, of whom--

(a) one shall be the State Librarian;

and

(b) seven shall be appointed by the Governor.
