An Act to amend the Loan from the Commonwealth Act, 1917, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, October 16th, 1919.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Loan from the Commonwealth Act Amendment Act, 1919." Short titles.

(2) The Loan from the Commonwealth Act, 1917 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act"), and this Act may be cited together as the "Loan from the Commonwealth Acts, 1917 and 1919." No. 1280 of 1917.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act, and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation with principal Act.

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the words "Six Million Five Hundred Thousand Pounds" in the last line thereof the words "Seven Million and Fifty-two Thousand Pounds." Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—
Power to borrow additional sum from Commonwealth Government.

4. This Act shall have the same effect as if it had been passed and had come into operation on the nineteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and fourteen. Act to be retrospective.
