An Act to amend the Loan from the Commonwealth Act, 1917, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, October 16th, 1919.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Loan from the Short titles. Commonwealth Act Amendment Act, 1919."

(2) The Loan from the Commonwealth Act, 1917 (hereinafter No. 1280 of 1917. referred to as "the principal Act"), and this Act may be cited together as the "Loan from the Commonwealth Acts, 1917 and 1919."

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act, and that Incorporation with Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by substituting Amendment of for the words "Six Million Five Hundred Thousand Pounds" in principal Act, s. 4the last line thereof the words "Seven Million and Fifty-two additional and for Thousand Pounds."

4. This Act shall have the same effect as if it had been passed Act to be and had come into operation on the nineteenth day of November, retrospectivenineteen hundred and fourteen.
