An Act to amend the Liquor Licensing Act, 1985.

[Assented to 30 April 1987]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the “Liquor Licensing Act Amendment Act, 1987”. Short title.
- (2) The Liquor Licensing Act, 1985, is in this Act referred to as “the principal Act”.
2. This Act will come into operation on the first day of January, 1988. Commencement.
3. Section 87 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (c) of subsection (2) and substituting the following paragraph: Amendment of s. 87—  
Licence fee.
  - (c) in relation to a producer’s licence—11 per cent of the gross amount paid or payable otherwise than by liquor merchants for the sale of liquor (not being wine, brandy or low alcohol liquor) during the relevant assessment period.
4. Section 93 of the principal Act is amended— Amendment of s. 93—  
Estimate by Commissioner on grant of retail or wholesale licence.
  - (a) by striking from subsection (1) “retail or wholesale”;
  - and
  - (b) by inserting after paragraph (b) of subsection (1) the following paragraph:
    - (c) in relation to a producer’s licence—of the gross amount that would have been paid or payable otherwise than by liquor merchants for the sale of liquor (not being wine, brandy or low alcohol liquor) during the relevant assessment period, if the licence had been in force during that assessment period.
