An Act to amend the Law of Property Act, 1936-1966, as amended.

[Assented to 11th December, 1969.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Law of Property Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1969".
- (2) The Law of Property Act, 1936-1966, as amended by this Act and by all Acts amending the same prior to the enactment of this Act, may be cited as the "Law of Property Act, 1936-1969".
- (3) The Law of Property Act, 1936-1966, as amended, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 105— Questions between husband and wife as to property. 3. Section 105 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "one thousand two hundred and fifty pounds" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "eight thousand dollars".
