## No. 1609.

An Act to amend the Lights on Vehicles Act, 1919, and to repeal the Lights on Vehicles Amendment Act, 1903.

[Assented to, October 2nd, 1924.]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Lights on Vehicles Act Amendment Act, 1924." Short titles.

(2) The Lights on Vehicles Act, 1919, and this Act may be cited together as the "Lights on Vehicles Acts, 1919 to 1924." No. 1370 of 1919.

2. The Lights on Vehicles Act, 1919, is amended by inserting after section 14 thereof the following section— Amendment of principal Act.

14a. Whenever in any proceedings for an offence against this Act, any place is described as a road such description shall be *prima facie* evidence that that place is a road within the meaning of this Act. Facilitation of proof.

3. The Lights on Vehicles Amendment Act, 1903, is hereby repealed. Repeal of Act No. 821 of 1903.
