An Act to amend the Lights on Vehicles Acts, 1919
to 1928.

[Assented to, November 12th, 1931.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia,
with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as
follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Lights on Vehicles Act Amendment Act, 1931". Short titles.

(2) The Lights on Vehicles Acts, 1919 to 1928, and this Act may be cited together as the "Lights on Vehicles Acts, 1919 to 1931".

(3) The Lights on Vehicles Act, 1919, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act". No. 1370 of 1919.

2. Section 6 of the principal Act (as amended by section 3 of the Lights on Vehicles Act Amendment Act, 1928) is further amended— Amendment of principal Act, s. 6—
Reflector on bicycles.

(a) by striking out the words "not less than one and a half inches in diameter";

(b) by inserting after the word "visible" in the penultimate line thereof the words "at a distance of at least forty feet"; and

(c) by adding at the end thereof the passage :—

"No such reflector shall be deemed to comply with this section unless—

(a) the reflector is not less than one and three-quarter inches in diameter; and

(b) the

- (b) the surface thereof is shaped or moulded into different planes; and
- (c) the underside thereof consists of a mirrored surface; and
- (d) the reflector is wholly surrounded by a white border not less than one-half an inch in width, or unless the reflector is of a kind (which may be different in any material from the reflector hereinbefore described) approved by the Chief Secretary on the recommendation of the Commissioner of Police."
