An Act to amend the Legal Practitioners Act, 1936-1938.

[Assented to 9th December, 1943.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Legal Practitioners short utles. Act Amendment Act, 1943".
- (2) The Legal Practitioners Act, 1936-1938, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Legal Practitioners Act, 1936-1943".
- (3) The Legal Practitioners Act, 1936-1938, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and this Act Incorporation. and that Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. Section 60a of the principal Act is amended by striking Amendment of out the words "before the thirty-first day of January, nineteen principal Act hundred and forty-four".
