An Act to amend the Law Society Act, 1915.

[Assented to, September 28th, 1921.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Law Society Act Amendment Act, 1921." Short titles.
- (2) The Law Society Act, 1915, and this Act may be cited together as the "Law Society Acts, 1915 and 1921." No. 1220 of 1915.
2. This Act is incorporated with the Law Society Act, 1915, and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation with Act 1220, 1915.
3. Subsection (3) of section 19 of the Law Society Act, 1915, is amended by substituting the word "seven" for the word "five" in the first line thereof. Amendment of Act 1220, 1915, s. 19 (3)—Statutory Committee to consist of seven members.
