An Act to amend the Land Settlement Act, 1944-1961.

[Assented to 7th November, 1963.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Land Settlement Act Amendment Act, 1963".

(2) The Land Settlement Act, 1944-1961, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Land Settlement Act, 1944-1963".

(3) The Land Settlement Act, 1944-1961, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 5.

3. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the principal Act is repealed and the following subsection is inserted in the principal Act in lieu thereof:—

(1) Subject to section 6 of this Act, every member of the committee holding office at the time of the passing of the Land Settlement Act Amendment Act, 1963, and any person appointed to a casual vacancy occurring on the committee before the thirty-first day of December, One

thousand nine hundred and sixty-five shall hold office until the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five.

4. Subsection (4) of section 27a of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "fifteen" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the word "seventeen".
