## An Act to amend the Land Settlement Act, 1944-1949.

[Assented to 13th September, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Land Settlement Act Short titles. Amendment Act, 1951".
- (2) The Land Settlement Act, 1944-1949, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Land Settlement Act, 1944-1951".
- (3) The Land Settlement Act, 1944-1949, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
  - 3. Section 10 of the principal Act is amended—

Amendment of principal Act, s. 10—

- (a) by striking out the words "four hundred" in subsection(1) and inserting in their place the words "two hundred and fifty";
- (b) by striking out the words "and fifty" in subsection (2).
