An Act to amend the Loans to Producers Act, 1927-1946.

[Assented to 11th October, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Loans to Producers Act Amendment Act, 1951".
- (2) The Loans to Producers Act, 1927-1946, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Loans to Producers Act, 1927-1951 ".
- (3) The Loans to Producers Act, 1927-1946, is hereinafter called the "principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Repeal of s. 4 of principal Act of the principal Act and enactment section is enacted in its place:— 3. Section 4 of the principal Act is repealed and the following

Financial provision.

4. The money required for the purposes of this Act shall be paid out of money voted by Parliament for those purposes.

4. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out in Amendment of the third and fourth lines of subsection (1) the words "out of principal Act the Loans to Producers Fund".

Loans to producers.

5. Section 5a of the principal Act is amended by striking out Amendment of in the first and second lines thereof the words "out of the principal Act-Loans to Producers Fund".

Loans for fallowing.

6. Section 5b of the principal Act is amended by striking out Amendment of in the first and second lines thereof the words "out of the principal Act-Loans to Producers Fund".

7. Section 13 of the principal Act is amended by striking out Amendment of the words "the Loans to Producers Fund" at the end of principal Actsubsection (2) thereof and inserting in their place the words "money provided by Parliament for the purposes of this Act."
