AN ACT for the Naturalization of certain Persons Natives of Germany.

WHEREAS Certain Persons Natives of Germany whose names are hereinafter mentioned have applied by Petition to His Excellency the Governor to be admitted to the rights and privileges of British Subjects and whereas it is expedient for the encouragement of Agriculture and in consequence of their good conduct and observance of the Laws during a period of eight months' residence in this Province that their said request should be complied with.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by His Excellency Lieutenant-Colonel George Gawler Knight of the Royal Hanoverian Guelphic Order Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Province of South Australia by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof that
