An Act to amend the National Parks and Wildlife Act, 1972-1981.

[Assented to 25th June, 1981]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "National Parks and Wildlife Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1981".

(2) The National Parks and Wildlife Act, 1972-1981, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "National Parks and Wildlife Act, 1972-1981".

Repeal of eighth schedule and substitution of new schedule.

2. The eighth schedule to the principal Act is repealed and the following schedule is substituted:
