An Act to apply, out of Consolidated Account, the sum of Four Hundred and Seventy-Five Million Dollars for the Public Service of the State for the financial year ending on 30 June, 1987.

[Assented to 13 March 1986]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act (No. 1), 1986".

Interpretation.

2. In this Act "the financial agreement" means the Financial Agreement made between the Commonwealth and the States as set out in the schedule to the Agreement contained in the Appendix to the Amending Financial Agreement Act, 1944, as amended by the Agreement set out in the schedule to the Amending Financial Agreement Act, 1966, and as amended by the Agreement set out in the schedule to the Amending Financial Agreement Act, 1976.

Issue and application of \$475 000 000.

3. Out of Consolidated Account there may be issued and applied, for the Public Service of the State for the financial year ending on 30 June, 1987, any money not exceeding in the aggregate four hundred and seventy-five million dollars.

Payments not to exceed amounts voted last year except in certain respects.

4. (1) No payments for any establishment or service shall be made out of the money referred to in section 3 in excess of the amounts voted for similar establishments or services for the financial year ended on 30 June, 1986, but there may be paid out of that money increases of salaries or wages payable by the Government of the State pursuant to any return made under the Acts relating to the Public Service, or pursuant to any regulation, or any award, order, or determination of a Court or other body empowered to fix salaries or wages.

(2) The Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay such increases out of that money.

5. During the period between 30 June, 1986, and the commencement of the Act authorizing the raising and expenditure of money for the financial year ending on 30 June, 1987, the Treasurer may borrow, on behalf of the State and subject to the financial agreement, the sum of eighty million dollars and such other sums as may be required for the purposes of the State. Power to borrow.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
