An Act to apply, out of the General Revenue, the further sum of Eight Hundred and Ninety-one Thousand and Five Pounds Ten Shillings and Sixpence, to the Service of the Year ending the Thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven.

[Assented to, 27th October, 1876.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows: Preamble.

1. Out of the General Revenue of the said Province there shall be issued and applied, from time to time, for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, any further sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Eight Hundred and Ninety-one Thousand and Five Pounds Ten Shillings and Sixpence to such services as shall then have been voted by the House of Assembly aforesaid.
