An Act to amend the Sandalwood Act, 1930.

[Assented to, 26th November, 1936.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Sandalwood Act Short titles. Amendment Act, 1936"

(2) The Sandalwood Acts, 1930 and 1933, and this Act may be cited together as the "Sandalwood Acts, 1930 to 1936".

(3) The Sandalwood Act, 1930, is in this Act called "the 1956, 1930. principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the Sandalwood Acts, 1930 Incorporation. and 1933, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by striking out Amendment of the definition of "sandalwood" therein and inserting in lieu  $\frac{1}{8.2}$ of that definition the following :----

"sandalwood" means the wood of any tree of the genus santalum or the genus fusanus and any other species of aromatic wood which is or may be used as a substitute for sandalwood.

4. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by striking out Amendment of principal Act, the words "thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and thirtyseven" and inserting in lieu thereof "thirty-first day of Duration of Act. October, nineteen hundred and forty".

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
