## A.D. 1943.

## No. 7 of 1943.

An Act to amend the Sandalwood Act, 1930-1940, so as to extend the period of operation thereof.

[Assented to 21st October, 1943.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Sandalwood Act Short titles. Amendment Act, 1943".

(2) The Sandalwood Act, 1930-1940, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Sandalwood Act, 1930-1943".

(3) The Sandalwood Act, 1930-1940, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and Incorporation. that Act and this Act may be cited as one Act.

**3.** Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by striking Amendment of out the word "forty-three" therein and inserting in lieu principal Actthereof the word "forty-six".

Extension of period of operation of principal Act.
