An Act to amend the South Australian Film Corporation Act, 1972-1975.

[Assented to 16th November, 1978]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "South Australian Film Corporation Act Amendment Act, 1978".
- (2) The South Australian Film Corporation Act, 1972-1975, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "South Australian Film Corporation Act, 1972-1978".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 3— Arrangement of Act.

3. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the item:

PART IV—THE ADVISORY BOARD

Amendment of principal Act, s. 4— Interpretation.

4. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the definition of "the advisory board".

Repeal of Part IV of principal Act.

5. Part IV of the principal Act (comprising sections 18 to 21 (inclusive) of the principal Act) is repealed.

Amendment of principal Act, a. 33—Regulations.

6. Section 33 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from paragraph (c) of subsection (2) the passage "and the advisory board".
