An Act to amend the South Australian Health Commission Act, 1976.

[Assented to 6 June 1985]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "South Australian Health Commission Act Amendment Act, 1985".

(2) The South Australian Health Commission Act, 1976, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of s. 60— Jurisdiction of Industrial Court. Industrial Commission and conciliation committees.

2. Section 60 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) after the passage "the Industrial Commission of South Australia" the passage "and any relevant conciliation committee";

(b) by striking out from paragraph (b) of subsection (1) the passage "or the Industrial Commission," and substituting the passage ", the Industrial Commission or any relevant conciliation committee";

(c) by striking out from paragraph (a) of subsection (4) the passage "or the Industrial Commission of South Australia" and substituting the passage ", the Industrial Commission or a conciliation committee";

and

(d) by striking out from paragraph (c) of subsection (4) the passage "or the Industrial Commission" and substituting the passage ", the Industrial Commission or a conciliation committee".
