An Act to amend the South Australian Institute of Technology Act, 1972.

[Assented to 4 September 1986]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "South Australian Institute of Short title. Technology Act Amendment Act, 1986".
- (2) The South Australian Institute of Technology Act, 1972, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
 - 2. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by striking out paragraph (b) of subsection (1) and substituting Continuance and the following paragraph:
 - (b) may, subject to subsection (3), acquire, hold, deal with and dispose of real and personal property;

and

- (b) by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsections:
 - (3) Subject to subsection (4), the Council shall not sell, mortgage, charge or otherwise dispose of any of its real property without the written consent of the Minister.
 - (4) The Council may, without the consent of the Minister, lease any of its real property for a term not exceeding 21 years at the best rental available.
