An Act to amend the South Australian Railways Commissioner's Act, 1936-1950.

[Assented to 14th November, 1957.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "South Australian Railways Commissioner's Act Amendment Act, 1957".
- (2) The South Australian Railways Commissioner's Act, 1936-1950, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "South Australian Railways Commissioner's Act, 1936-1957".
- (3) The South Australian Railways Commissioner's Act, 1936-1950, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 183— By-laws.

- 3. Section 133 of the principal Act is amended by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (p):—
 - (pa) For the prevention of pilfering of parcels and goods from railway property, and in particular for the purpose of authorizing railway detectives:—
 - (i) to stop and detain any vehicle or person upon any land or buildings vested in or under the control of the Commissioner where or near where any parcels or goods are received, despatched or delivered; and

- (ii) to inspect and search any such vehicle or any container, parcel or article in the possession of any such person; and
- (iii) to demand the production by any such person of consignment notes or other documents relating to any parcels or goods found as a result of any such inspection or search; and
- (iv) to seize and retain any parcels or goods found upon such inspection or search which the detective making the inspection or search reasonably suspects of having been stolen or illegally obtained.
