An Act to amend the South Australian Railways Commissioner's Act, 1936-1973.

[Assented to 5th December, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "South Australian Railways Commissioner's Act Amendment Act, 1974".
- (2) The South Australian Railways Commissioner's Act, 1936-1973, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "South Australian Railways Commissioner's Act, 1936-1974".

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 105—
Sale of liquor at Adelaide
Railway
Station.

- 3. Section 105 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out the passage "ten o'clock in the evening" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "twelve o'clock midnight";
 - (b) by inserting immediately after the passage "Good Friday" the passage "and for consumption with or ancillary to a bona fide meal being taken at those refreshment rooms to any person between the hours of half past eleven o'clock in the morning and nine 'clock in the evening on any Sunday";

Amendment of principal Act, s. 133—
By-laws.

4. Section 133 of the principal Act is amended by inserting immediately after the word "rooms" in paragraph (ba) the passage "or other place".
