## No. 28 of 1973

An Act to amend the Audit Act, 1921, as amended ; the Police Regulation Act, 1952, as amended ; the Public Service Act, 1967, as amended ; the Valuation of Land Act, 1971, as amended, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 20th September, 1973]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

## AMENDMENT OF AUDIT ACT

Short titles.

3. (1) The Audit Act, 1921-1972, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Audit Act, 1921-1973".

(2) The Audit Act, 1921-1972, is in this Part referred to as "the principal Act".

4. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—

(1) As from, and including, the fourth day of June, 1973, until, but not including, the twenty-seventh day of August, 1973, the Auditor-General shall receive a salary at the rate of twenty-one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six dollars a year and as from, and including, the twenty-seventh day of August, 1973, the Auditor-General shall receive a salary at the rate of twenty-five thousand four hundred dollars a year.

## AMENDMENT OF POLICE REGULATION ACT

Short titles.

5. (1) The Police Regulation Act, 1952, as amended by this Act and by all other amendments amending the same prior to the commencement of this Act, may be cited as the "Police Regulation Act, 1952-1973".

(2) The Police Regulation Act, 1952, as amended by all other amendments amending the same prior to the commencement of this Act, is in this Part referred to as "the principal Act".

6. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—

(1) As from, and including, the fourth day of June, 1973, until, but not including, the twenty-seventh day of August, 1973, the salary of the Commissioner shall be at the rate of twenty thousand two hundred and twenty-four dollars a year and as from, and including, the twenty-seventh day of August, 1973, the salary of the Commissioner shall be at the rate of twenty-three thousand five hundred dollars a year.

## AMENDMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE ACT

7. (1) The Public Service Act, 1967-1972, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Public Service Act, 1967-1973". Short titles.

(2) The Public Service Act, 1967-1972, is in this Part referred to as "the principal Act".

8. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:— Amendment of principal Act, s. 15—  
Salary and expenses of Commissioners.

(1) As from, and including, the fourth day of June, 1973, until, but not including, the twenty-seventh day of August, 1973, the salary of the Commissioner nominated Chairman of the Board shall be at the rate of twenty-one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six dollars a year and the salary of each other Commissioner shall be at the rate of eighteen thousand six hundred and ninety-four dollars a year and as from, and including, the twenty-seventh day of August, 1973, the salary of the Commissioner nominated Chairman of the Board shall be at the rate of twenty-five thousand four hundred dollars a year and the salary of each other Commissioner shall be at the rate of twenty-two thousand dollars a year.

## AMENDMENT OF VALUATION OF LAND ACT

9. (1) The Valuation of Land Act, 1971-1972, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Valuation of Land Act, 1971-1973".

(2) The Valuation of Land Act, 1971-1972, is in this Part referred to as "the principal Act".

**10.** Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—

(1) As from, and including, the fourth day of June, 1973, until, but not including, the twenty-seventh day of August, 1973, the salary of the Valuer-General shall be at the rate of fifteen thousand nine hundred and ninety-one dollars a year and as from, and including, the twenty-seventh day of August, 1973, the salary of the Valuer-General shall be at the rate of eighteen thousand dollars a year.
