An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1969.

[Assented to 26th June, 1969.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1969".

(2) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1969, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act, 1935-1969".

(3) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1969, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after the passage "for the time being" in subsection (1) the word "fully";

(b) by inserting before the word "execution" in subsection (1) the word "full";

(c) by inserting after the word "duties" lastly occurring in subsection (1) the passage "or to act as a judge for such period as the Governor thinks fit";

and

(d) by inserting after the word "time" lastly occurring in subsection (4) the passage "or that he should continue in office after that time for any other reason that the Governor deems proper,".

3. Section 12 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after the passage “Chief Justice” wherever it occurs in subsection (1) the passage “or acting Chief Justice”;

and

(b) by inserting after the passage “puisne judge” wherever it occurs in subsection (1) the passage “or acting puisne judge”.
