## No. 49 of 1965

An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1965.

[Assented to 9th December, 1965.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1965".
- (2) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1965, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act, 1935-1965".
- (3) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1965, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 123. Section 12 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is inserted in the principal Act in lieu thereof:—

Salaries of Judges.

- 12. (1) The salary of the Chief Justice shall be at the rate of seven thousand six hundred pounds a year and the salary of every Puisne Judge shall be at the rate of six thousand eight hundred and fifty pounds a year.
- (2) The rates of salary fixed by subsection (1) of this section shall be deemed to have come into force for all purposes (including contributions for pension and rights to pension) on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five.

(3) Such salaries shall be paid by the Treasurer out of the General Revenue of the State on the warrant of the Governor, which warrant the Governor is hereby authorized and required to issue from time to time.
