**An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1982.**

*[Assented to 14 April 1983]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1983".

(2) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1982, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act, 1935-1983".

Amendment of s. 72—  
Rules of Court.

2. Section 72 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph VI of subsection (1).

Insertion of new s. 130.

3. The following section is inserted after section 129 of the principal Act:

Power to prescribe and provide for payment of court fees.

130. (1) The Governor may, by regulation, prescribe and provide for the payment of fees in respect of proceedings in the court, or any step in such proceedings.

(2) Any rules made under section 72 (1) VI and in force immediately before the commencement of the Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1983, shall be deemed to be regulations made under this section.
