An Act to increase by twenty-five per centum the Duty payable under the Succession Duties Act, 1929, during the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and thirty-one.

[Assented to, November 27th, 1929.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Succession Duties Act Amendment Act, 1929". Short titles.

(2) The Succession Duties Act, 1929 (which is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act"), and this Act may be cited together as the "Succession Duties Acts of 1929". No. 1898 of 1929.

2. Section 42 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "thirty" in the last line thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "thirty-one". Amendment of principal Act, s. 42—
Temporary continuance of increase of succession duties.
