An Act to amend the Stock Diseases Act, 1934-1956.

[Assented to 19th November, 1959.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Stock Diseases Act short utles. Amendment Act, 1959".
- (2) The Stock Diseases Act, 1934-1956, as amended by this Act may be cited as the "Stock Diseases Act, 1934-1959".
- (3) The Stock Diseases Act, 1934-1956, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the principal Act is Amendment of principal Act, s. 5—
  Interpretation.

(a) by inserting before the interpretation of "camel" the following interpretation:—

"animal product" means and includes meat, fat, milk, whey, cream, butter, cheese, eggs, or semen of any stock:

(b) by inserting in the interpretation of "carcass" after the word "hoofs" therein, the words "feathers, blood, viscera,";

- (c) by inserting after paragraph (c) in the interpretation of "stock" therein the following new paragraph:—
  - (d) Any animal product of any stock as hereinbefore defined:
