An Act to amend the Second-hand Dealers Act, 1919-1963.

[Assented to 22nd October, 1964.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:—

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Second-hand Dealers Act Amendment Act, 1964".
- (2) The Second-hand Dealers Act, 1919-1963, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Second-hand Dealers Act, 1919-1964".
- (3) The Second-hand Dealers Act, 1919-1963, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 3.

- 3. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the definition of "licensee" therein the following definition:—
 - "public holiday" means any day, other than the day after Good Friday, which is by or under The Holidays Act, 1910-1959, declared to be a public holiday;.
 - In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
