An Act to amend the Securities Industry Act, 1979.

[Assented to 4 December 1980]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Securities Industry Act Amendment Act, 1980". Short titles.

(2) The Securities Industry Act, 1979, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Securities Industry Act, 1979-1980".

2. Section 40 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from paragraph (b) of subsection (1) the passage "the Commissioner" and substituting the passage "the Commission". Amendment of s. 40—
Conditions to which licence is subject.

3. Section 47 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from paragraph (b) of subsection (1) the passage "the Commissioner" and substituting the passage "the Commission". Amendment of s. 47—
Revocation and suspension of licences.
