## No. 13 of 1977

An Act to amend the State Transport Authority Act, 1974-1975.

[Assented to 5th May, 1977]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "State Transport Authority Act Amendment Act, 1977". Short titles.

(2) The State Transport Authority Act, 1974-1975, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "State Transport Authority Act, 1974-1977".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—

(1) On and after the commencement of the State Transport Authority Act Amendment Act, 1977, the Authority shall consist of eight members appointed by the Governor on the nomination of the Minister.;

and

(b) by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection:—

(3) The Chairman and members of the Authority appointed pursuant to this section and in office immediately

before the commencement of the State Transport Authority Act Amendment Act, 1977, shall continue in office for the balance of the term for which they were appointed.

4. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (2) the word “four” and inserting in lieu thereof the word “five”.
