**No. 104 of 1981****An Act to amend the State Theatre Company of South Australia Act, 1972-1979.***[Assented to 23 December 1981]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "State Theatre Company of South Australia Act Amendment Act, 1981". Short titles.

(2) The State Theatre Company of South Australia Act, 1972-1979, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "State Theatre Company of South Australia Act, 1972-1981".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (2) the word "six" and substituting the word "eight"; Amendment of s. 6—  
The Board of Governors.

and

(b) by striking out from paragraph (a) of subsection (2) the word "three" and substituting the word "five".

4. Section 10 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (4) the word "three" and substituting the word "four". Amendment of s. 10—  
Procedures of the Board.
