An Act to amend the Shop Trading Hours Act, 1977.

[Assented to 2 May 1985]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Shop Trading Hours Act Amendment Act, 1985".
- (2) The Shop Trading Hours Act, 1977, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement,

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of s. 13— Closing times for shops.

- 3. Section 13 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsections (4), (5), (5a), (5b), (5c) and (5d) and substituting the following subsection:
  - (4) Subject to this section but notwithstanding anything in subsection (1) or (2), the closing time for a shop the business of which is solely or predominantly the retail sale of meat shall be as follows:
    - (a) for a shop situated in a shopping district or part of a shopping district to which subsection (1) applies—
      - (i) 5.30 p.m. on every weekday other than a Friday;
      - (ii) 9 p.m. on a Friday;

and

- (iii) 12.30 p.m. on a Saturday;
- (b) for a shop situated in a shopping district or part of a shopping district to which subsection (1) does not apply—
  - (i) 5.30 p.m. on every weekday other than a Thursday;
  - (ii) 9 p.m. on a Thursday;

and

(iii) 12.30 p.m. on a Saturday;

- (c) for a shop situated outside a shopping district—
  - (i) 5.30 p.m. on four weekdays in each week;
  - (ii) 9.00 p.m. on one weekday in each week; and
  - (iii) 12.30 p.m. on a Saturday.
