An Act to amend the Shop Trading Hours Act, 1977.

[Assented to 2 May 1985]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Shop Trading Hours Act Amendment Act, 1985".

(2) The Shop Trading Hours Act, 1977, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of
s. 13—
Closing times for
shops.

3. Section 13 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsections (4), (5), (5a), (5b), (5c) and (5d) and substituting the following subsection:

(4) Subject to this section but notwithstanding anything in subsection (1) or (2), the closing time for a shop the business of which is solely or predominantly the retail sale of meat shall be as follows:

(a) for a shop situated in a shopping district or part of a shopping district to which subsection (1) applies—

(i) 5.30 p.m. on every weekday other than a Friday;

(ii) 9 p.m. on a Friday;

and

(iii) 12.30 p.m. on a Saturday;

(b) for a shop situated in a shopping district or part of a shopping district to which subsection (1) does not apply—

(i) 5.30 p.m. on every weekday other than a Thursday;

(ii) 9 p.m. on a Thursday;

and

(iii) 12.30 p.m. on a Saturday;

- (c) for a shop situated outside a shopping district—
- (i) 5.30 p.m. on four weekdays in each week;
 - (ii) 9.00 p.m. on one weekday in each week;
- and
- (iii) 12.30 p.m. on a Saturday.
