### No. 2340.

An Act to amend the University of Adelaide Act, 1935.

[Assented to 15th September, 1937.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the " University of Adelaide Act Amendment Act, 1937 ". Short titles.

(2) The University of Adelaide Act, 1935, as amended by this Act may be cited as the " University of Adelaide Act, 1935-1937 ". 2228, 1935.

(3) The University of Adelaide Act, 1935, is in this Act referred to as " the principal Act ".

2. Subsection (1) of section 25 of the principal Act is repealed and the following subsection is enacted in lieu thereof :— Amendment of s. 25 of the principal Act—

(1) In addition to any other sums payable to the university out of the general revenue of the State, the Treasurer shall in each of the seven financial years commencing with the financial year 1937-1938, pay to the university the sum of fifteen thousand pounds. Grants for agricultural research.

3. (1) Paragraph II. of section 26 of the principal Act is amended by inserting the word " botany " before the words " plant pathology " therein. Amendment of s. 26 of the principal Act—

(2) Paragraph IV. of section 26 of the principal Act is amended by striking out all the words therein after " standard ". Conditions of grant.

(3) The following paragraph is inserted at the end of section 26 :—

v. The Director of the Waite Agricultural Research Institute shall in every year furnish the Minister of Agriculture with a report on the work of the Institute during the preceding year, and the Minister of Agriculture shall lay the report before Parliament at the earliest convenient time.

4. As from the twenty-fourth day of December, nineteen hundred and thirty-seven, section 27 of the principal Act shall be repealed.

Consequential  
repeal of third  
schedule.

5. The third schedule to the principal Act is repealed.
