An Act to amend the Weights and Measures Act, 1934-1953.

[Assented to 16th October, 1958.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Weights and Measures Act Amendment Act, 1958".
- (2) The Weights and Measures Act, 1934-1953, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Weights and Measures Act, 1934-1958".
- (3) The Weights and Measures Act, 1934-1953 is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act s. 8.

New denominations of standards.

3. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out in the fourth to eighth lines the words "be either equivalent to or multiples or aliquot parts of the standards of weight and measure for the State or shall be equivalent to or multiples of each coin of the realm for the time being and shall".
