An Act to amend the Workmen's Compensation Acts, 1911 to 1927.

[Assented to, November 15th, 1932.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Workmen's Compensation Act, 1932". Short titles.

(2) The Workmen's Compensation Acts, 1911 to 1927, and this Act may be cited together as the "Workmen's Compensation Acts, 1911 to 1932".

2. Subparagraph (b) of paragraph (1) of the First Schedule to the principal Act (as re-enacted by section 9 of the Workmen's Compensation Act Further Amendment Act, 1924), is amended by inserting therein after the first proviso thereto the following additional proviso :— Amendment of Workmen's Compensation Act, 1911, First Schedule— Minimum compensation.

Provided further that notwithstanding subdivision (ii.) of subparagraph (b) of this paragraph a workman of or above the age of twenty-one years who is a married man with or without children, or a widower having a child or children under the age of fourteen years totally or mainly dependent upon his earnings and whose average weekly earnings during such period as aforesaid did not exceed Thirty-five Shillings, shall receive during total incapacity the sum of Thirty-five Shillings per week, and a workman of or above the age of twenty-one years who is a single man or a widower not having a child or children under the age of fourteen years totally or mainly dependent on his earnings, and whose average weekly earnings during the period aforesaid did not exceed Twenty-five Shillings, shall receive during total incapacity the sum of Twenty-five Shillings per week.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
